WGC-2027 Reduced Registration Fee Categories

Reduced Fee for Glaucoma Society Member

WGA offers a reduction on registration fees for members of national/regional affiliated glaucoma societies. If you are a member of one of the societies, you can apply for the reduced fee during the online registration. Please be informed that all applications will be checked with the corresponding Glaucoma Societies.

Allied Healthcare Professionals (Nurses, Orthoptists and Opticians)

To be able to register for the Allied Healthcare Professionals fee (Nurses, Orthoptists and Opticians) individuals must present proof of employment as Nurse, Orthoptist or Optician at the time of registration. The proof of employment is required during the registration process, as we request the applicant to upload a letter signed by the employer on official letterhead. The file to upload can be a pdf or image file (max file size: 200 KB).

Research Scientists

To be able to register for the Research Scientists fee, individuals must present proof of employment as Research Scientist at the time of registration. The proof of employment is required during the registration process, as we request the applicant to upload a letter signed by the employer on official letterhead. The file to upload can be a pdf or image file (max file size: 200 KB).

Students, Physicians & Scientists in Training

To be able to register for the Student fee (Students, Physicians & Scientists in training), individuals must present proof of fulltime enrolment at a recognized university/institute at both the time of registration and during the congress dates. During the registration process, the applicant must upload a letter signed by the head of the relevant university/institute department and stamped with the university/institute official stamp. The file to upload can be a pdf or image file (max file size: 200 KB).

Participants from Low Income Countries

Participants from Low Income Countries as classified by the World Bank will automatically receive a discounted registration fee, no proof needs to be provided.

The World Bank currently defines the following countries as Low-income countries: Afghanistan, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Central African Republic, Chad, Dem. Rep. Congo, Eritrea, Ethiopia, The Gambia, Guinea-Bissau, Dem. People's Rep Korea, Liberia, Madagascar, Malawi, Mali, Mozambique, Niger, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan, Syrian Arab Republic, Uganda, Rep Yemen (correct as of July 6, 2026.)
